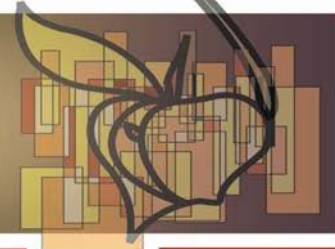

DAY ONE: Friday, April 3, 2015 – ARRIVE INTO NEW YORK CITY!

Morning: Arrive at a San Francisco Bay Area airport and check in for flight. After checking in proceed through security and on to your departure gate. You may want to purchase food at the airport at this time to take on the plane with you.

Afternoon: Arrive into one of the area's airports where you will be met by a World Projects staff member who will direct you to your coaches. Transfer to a Midtown Manhattan hotel (likely the Hilton Hotel in Midtown - TBC). You will be met at the hotel by a World Projects staff member, who will assist with check-in.

Situated in the Midtown area of Manhattan, the festival hotel is within easy walking distance to Times Square, Central Park, Rockefeller Center, and some of the most amazing restaurants and shopping known on the planet! The Midtown area includes the Theatre District, the Diamond District, the Garment District, and major television studios.

Evening: Dinner on your own in the Times Square area.



DAY TWO: Saturday, April 4, 2015 – NEW YORK CITY (D)

Morning: Breakfast on your own in the vicinity of the hotel. Today is entirely free to explore the Times Square area or enjoy a group sightseeing activity. *Possibly explore beyond Midtown to neighborhoods such as Harlem, Chinatown, Greenwich Village, or Little Italy. Enjoy a ferry ride by the Statue of Liberty, with a guided tour of Ellis Island and the 9/11 Memorial. Visit the exhibits of world class museums such as the Museum of Modern Art, the American Museum of Natural History, or the Guggenheim. (World Projects can coordinate what you want to do - additional costs apply).*

Evening: Dinner as a group (possibly at John's Pizzeria - TBC).



DAY THREE: Sunday, April 5, 2015 – NEW YORK CITY (D) – Workshop

Morning: Breakfast on your own in the vicinity of the hotel. Enjoy a group **workshop** with a Festival clinician (location TBC). Afterwards return instruments to your rooms.

Afternoon: Lunch on your own. After lunch return to the hotel to freshen up prior to meeting to walk over to a Broadway Show. Enjoy a Matinee Broadway Show (TBC – tickets up to a \$75 value).

Evening: After the show enjoy dinner as a group (possibly Ellen's Stardust Diner – TBC).

DAY FOUR: Monday, April 6, 2015 – NEW YORK CITY (D) – Outdoor Performance

- Morning:** Breakfast on your own in the vicinity of the hotel. This morning, groups will be transported to the outdoor performance venue (possibly the Central Park Bandshell or Battery Park – TBC – weather permitting).
- Afternoon:** Enjoy your **outdoor “pops-style” performance!** Return to the hotel. You will have some free time for lunch on own and to explore the Times Square area.
- Evening:** Meet in the lobby and load coaches for the Festival Dinner Cruise! Eat, dance to DJ music, and enjoy the sights (including a stunning view of the Statue of Liberty) as you cruise along the Hudson River with other Festival participants. Following the cruise, load coaches and return to the hotel.



DAY FIVE: Tuesday, April 7, 2015 – NEW YORK CITY – Carnegie Hall Performance / Dessert Social

- Morning:** Breakfast on your own in the vicinity of the hotel. Wind Symphony will meet in the lobby of the hotel in performance attire with instruments. Arrive at Carnegie Hall for your group sound check. Following your sound check, store instruments in your warm up room. Lunch on own in the area.
- Afternoon:** Return to Carnegie Hall for your *performance* as part of the Afternoon Adjudicated Concert in Isaac Stern Auditorium!
- Confirmed ensembles include:**
- ♫ Evergreen Valley High School Orchestra, from San Jose, CA
 - ♫ Beckman High School Orchestra, from Irvine, CA
- Evening:** After your performance return to the hotel to secure instruments and change. Dinner on your own in the Times Square area. After dinner return to Carnegie Hall for the **Evening Showcase Concert** featuring:
- ♫ Evergreen Valley High School Wind Ensemble, from San Jose, CA
 - ♫ Kansas State University Wind Ensemble, from Manhattan, KS
 - ♫ Göppinger Jugendsinfonieorchester, from Goppingen, Germany
- Following the concert is the Awards Ceremony. Return to the hotel to store instruments. Enjoy a Cheesecake Social at the Carnegie Deli to celebrate your performance! (TBC) Afterwards, return to the hotel.



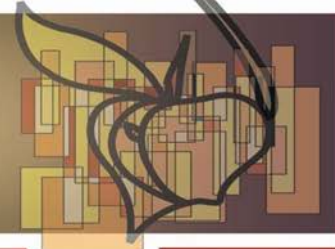
DAY SIX: Wednesday, April 8, 2015 – NEW YORK CITY → HOME

Package Inclusions

- ◆ ESTIMATED Roundtrip airfare from an SF Bay Area airport to a New York City Area airport (see air note below)

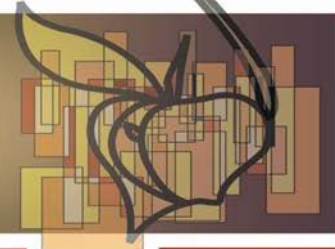
Package Exclusions

Notes:

- ♫ **Air:** ESTIMATED Air of \$450 per person has been included in the above costs. World Projects will source air seats once they become available in May/June, 2014 and inform Foothill HS on cost, itinerary, and payment schedule. World Projects reserves the right to pass on any increase in airfare should the actual fare come in higher than estimated. Once booked, only the base fare is guaranteed – taxes and surcharges are subject to change until ticketing – should additional taxes or surcharges be levied, World Projects retains the right to pass on all such surcharges to Foothill HS.
- ♫ **Baggage:** ESTIMATED baggage fees for a first checked bag for each traveler has been included in the above costs. In addition to this bag fees for instruments required to be checked as second bags. Most airlines charge for first and second checked bags and for oversize/weight fees. Once an airline has been selected for travel World Projects will inform Foothill HS of the selected airlines baggage policies and current fees.
- ♫ **Rooming:** Quad denotes four (4) people per room, two double beds per room. Triple denotes three (3) people per room, two double beds per room. Sharing beds for quad and triple occupancy will be necessary. Double or single occupancy rooms could have two double beds, one queen size, or one king size bed in the room. Hotel rooms will be held on a “first come — first served” basis.
- ♫ **Ground Costs:** Costs are based on 2014 prices. Once actual 2015 prices are available in mid-2014, World Projects reserves the right to re-cost the tour should any price increase apply.
- ♫ **Payment:** All payments must be made by school check, bank check or cash – credit cards will not be accepted.
- ♫ **Numbers:** World Projects reserves the right to re-cost this proposal should the group not meet the minimum of 68 travelers.
- ♫ **Agreement:** Once agreed and deposited on, World Projects will issue a Performance Agreement detailing costs and inclusions/exclusions for all parties to sign.
