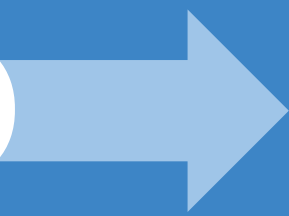

THE REMOTE MUSICIAN

TIPS FOR PARENTS TO HELP THEIR FOOTHILL MUSIC MEMBER BE SUCCESSFUL DURING SOCIAL DISTANCING

DO



- Create a safe and nurturing musical atmosphere that encourages growth and risk-taking.
- Give your musician space - they may not yet be ready to share what they have been working on.
- Offer encouragement and positive feedback
- Monitor sibling responses

- Tease them about their singing or playing
- Draw attention to their skills before they are ready to share
- Offer unsolicited advice - young musicians may be easily embarrassed, especially with family members

Suggestions on how to respond to your child's frustration...

- "Well I have noticed these good things..."
- "You're learning and growing, it's okay not to be perfect!"
- "You may not be able to do it YET, but you'll get it!"
- "I am so proud of you for challenging yourself!"

Young musicians will most likely experience things like voice changes, extended ranges, and other new challenges that are tricky to navigate at home. Encourage them to power through the cracks and squeaks, and remind them that those are only temporary!
